It is planned to hold an **Auction of Promises** on 12<sup>th</sup> April. All money to the renovation project. Examples of promises:

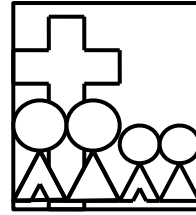
- *A trip to the lovely village of Ludgershall with afternoon tea chez Rosentall*
